
RCIIS has a family atmosphere. Students feel at home here at RCIIS with the personalized



## ESL FOUNDATION

This successful multi-skill syllabus integrates functions with forms.





## POWER SPEAKING I, II, III & IV

This innovative program is up to 24 weeks, it builds strong communication skills and confidence with the focus on speaking. Our unique syllabus emphasizes the fluidity of English speech, so students speak more naturally and with greater fluency. The program reinforces and improves speaking skills using a two part system.

1. Learning and understanding topical relevant vocabulary and expressions, which native speakers commonly use; including intonation and pronunciation sounds.
2. Interactive activities which are designed to be fun and increase fluency skills.

- Active class conversation
- Role playing exercises
- Daily individual "1 minute Power Speaking" (Expressing an opinion on a familiar topic.)

- Word, sentence stress & intonation focus.
- Pair and group work created dialogues using learned expressions

- Recorded individual assessments (for some levels of PS program.)


## ADVANCED DISCUSSION CONTEMPORARY ISSUES

## PRE ACADEMIC ENGLISH

### Program Description

This course not only aims to provide a foundation to IELTS and EAP programs, but also to help students attain a higher level of ESL proficiency where they are using English with ease. Placement tests will be conducted at the beginning and end of the training course to showcase how much progress the students have made during their term of the IELTS training course. # ENGLISH ACADEMIC PURPOSE



# BUSINESS COMMUNICATION

This course is designed as a general introduction to concepts and vocabulary associated with the modern business world. Business affects us all in many different ways, both on a personal level and also by the general economic environment. The focus is mainly on discussion with an emphasis on oral communication.

The course serves three functions:

- 1) it prepares students for employment with English being the primary language.
- 2) it increases the general fluency level of the student.
- 3) it provides analytical skills in a vital area which can be applied to general real world situations.



## STAR-ACCENT REDUCTION & DRAMA PROGRAMS

The STAR program, an acronym for Stage Technique Accent Reduction, is a unique fusion of advanced pronunciation systems and stage acting techniques which serve to give students the theory need to create native-style speech while simultaneously allowing them to practice learned theory in a realistic speaking environment. STAR is extremely specific in regard to muscle movement, and does not rely on continuous repetition to produce accurate vocalization, instead using clear and easy to understand muscle training systems.

### CURRICULUM TOPICS

#### STAR 1

Teaches the fundamental skills required for clear English speech, using a five point system to focus on all important areas.

- Intonation
- Rhythm
- Pronunciation
- Muscle Training
- Expression

#### STAR 2

Includes advanced instruction and practice in the above areas, as well as additional focus on the following topics:

- Natural/Colloquial Rhythm
- Literacy Skills
- Listening Comprehension

These options allow students to take more classes according to their preference or schedule.

You can decide on a package which best suits your budget, learning goals, and the length of your stay. It is recommended, however, to take more intensive packages to enhance your learning output. The programs in the intensive packages often compliment each other and cover a wide range of important skills. Our counselors will assist you in choosing the appropriate programs after assessing your level of English on your first day of school.

# ADMISSION & ORIENTATION

## Admission Procedure

- Submit the ONLINE REGISTRATION FORM (<http://rciisapplication.ca>) or Complete by fax, email or mail.
- We send you an invoice for the full fees.
- Payment by wire transfer, bank draft or money order to Royal Canadian Institute of International Studies.
- We send you a Letter of Acceptance and receipt once full payment of fees is received.
- Apply for a visa, if needed, once you receive your Letter of Acceptance

## Visa & Immigration

To study in Canada, you may need a study permit, and/or a temporary resident visa, though not everyone must have these documents.

Please read carefully the Citizenship & Immigration Canada website (<http://www.cic.gc.ca/english/study/study.asp>) or consult with the Canadian High Commission in your country.

To obtain your entry visa to Canada, you must present a valid passport and a Letter of Acceptance from RCIS to Canadian authorities. You must also be prepared to show that you have sufficient financial resources to cover the cost of your stay and your studies while here.

## HEALTH INSURANCE

The Government of Canada does not pay for the medical costs for foreign students. The medical expenses for emergency, sudden illness or accident while studying in Canada could cause a fortune without adequate coverage.

Students are responsible to obtain and maintain medical insurance for the duration of your study.

RCIS recommends that all students have Health Insurance for the full duration of their stay in Canada. health insurance plan is available to all students for \$2.00/day.

## On Your First Day

On your first day, you should expect the following schedule:

- Submission of your passport, visa, and insurance policy
- You will receive an introductory greeting from our counselors and a confirmation of your course registration.
- You will be seated while waiting for your placement test. This test consists of 2 parts: a speaking test, and a written test.
- Your name will be called for the placement test which will decide what level and programs you need to begin with.
- After the placement test, our staff will give you a general orientation regarding the school and its policies.
- Please listen very carefully to our orientation; some of the school policies are very important for your success at RCIS.
- At the end of the orientation, you will have the opportunity to take part in a small group discussion with our counselors who speak your native language. They will answer some of your questions and make copies of your passport, visa and insurance policies.
- After the session with our counselors, you will be dismissed from school for the day. We will inform you regarding the arrangement of your class and schedule via email towards the end of the day.
- RCIS requires all students to speak only in English while at school, starting from your first day. We hope you enjoy your time with RCIS!

# REFUND POLICY

## Refund Policies

The registration fee, all placement fees and all Health Insurance Policy purchase fee are non-refundable in ALL cases. A refund of fees will not be given if a student does not attend classes. Please consider when applying that student authorization or visitors visas can take up to several weeks to process.

Students have a 48-hour contract cancellation period prior to signing the registration contract.

## Rejected VISA

If your visa is rejected, RCIS will refund all fees, minus the registration fee, only upon receipt of the original Letter of Acceptance and the official letter of refusal from the Canadian Embassy.

Cancellation after Getting Student VISA

There is no refund of any fee for applicants who have successfully received their visas with the Letter of Acceptance and other documents and assistance from RCIS.

Cancellation before the Start of Program

If RCIS receives written notice of withdrawal from the student along with the original Letter of Acceptance issued by the school at least 30 calendar days before the start of the program, a cancellation fee of 25% of the total tuition fee will be charged. If less than 30 calendar days, a cancellation fee of 50% of the total tuition fee will be charged.

## Cancellation after the Start Date & Dismissal

If for any reason, a student is dismissed from RCIS, no refund will be made on the subsequent month's tuition.

The tuition fees are non-transferable.

\*students register with more than 2 programs with package discount, there is no refund for any cancellation of individual program.

## Absence/Vacation

Students absent for more than 1 week, without notifying the school in writing, will be removed from the class and will have to re-enter the school. Unless inform the school in written before or on registration, any vacation will be not be permitted, tuition fee cannot be extended for the vacation time for any reason, therefore you will not receive Letter of Attendance from school.

## Deferrals

You may defer your registration start date one time only, you will be charged a 10% of tuition fee as deferral fee before the start date. Defer your program after starting the program, a 25% of tuition fee as deferral fee will be charged and the institute will decide your returning session. There will be no deferrals for the second term.

## Applying through an Authorized Representative

Must request and obtain refund directly from the representative.

## Accommodation Refund

The Accommodation and Airport Pick-up fee placement fees are non-refundable. 100% refund if cancellation is received in writing at least 30 days prior to arrival date. 75% refund if cancellation is received in writing 0 to 29 days prior to arrival date.

## Leaving Homestay

Students must inform the host and school of moving out at least 4 weeks before it is to take place. Otherwise, students will be charged until the 4 weeks are met.

Homestay fee will be refunded directly to the students from hosts at the time of moving out.

Refund=remaining days x daily rate (monthly homestay fee/28 days)
